A copy of the insurance policy must be provided by the Member Federation on request, including applicable benefits (such as death and capital benefits, loss of income and non-medicare medical expenses), exclusions, maximum benefits and deductions;
- to submit exclusively to the jurisdiction of the Grievance Resolution Regulations and to not attempt to resolve any dispute or grievance the subject matter of the FFA Statutes in a court of law;
- the Applicant's registration is with the Member Federation and FFA until the expiration of his or her FFA accreditation; and
- FFA and the Member Federation may de-register the Applicant at any time by notice in person or sent to the address above, including if these Terms or its incorporated documents are not complied with.
